**Introduction:**

Kakinada is one of the hundred Smart Cities selected by Government of India in First Round. The Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) incorporated with the name of “Kakinada Smart City Corporation Limited” (KMC) under companies’ act 2013 on 07-03-2016.

Meat manure also known as chicken, mutton and fish waste is the feces of chickens used as an organic fertilizer, especially for soil low in nitrogen. Of all animal manures, chicken has the highest amount of nitrogen, phosphorus, and potassium. Meat manure is sometimes pelletized for use as a fertilizer, and this product may have additional phosphorus, potassium or nitrogen added. Optimal storage conditions for chicken manure include keeping it in a covered area and retaining its liquid, because a significant amount of nitrogen exists in the urine

Fresh chicken manure contains 0.5% to 0.9% nitrogen, 0.4%[4] to 0.5% phosphorus, and 1.2% to 1.7 %potassium. One chicken produces approximately 8–11 pounds of manure monthly. Chicken manure can be used to create homemade plant fertilizer.

When manure is applied to fishponds, best results are obtained with frequent applications. ... The food web, leading from the manure applied to the fish-flesh produced, is discussed in terms of direct feeding, source of minerals for autotrophic production and source of organic matter for heterotrophic production.

Animal Manure is organic matter that is used as organic fertilizer in agriculture. and contribute to the fertility of soil by adding organic matter and nutrients, such as nitrogen, that are utilized by bacteria, fungi and other organisms in the soil.

KMC likely to take up meat waste and disposal duly following conditions Whereas, since number of measures have to be initiated by the government to maintain the amenities proposed technically required, for the viability of the Chicken waste, Financial factor is main concern to be looked after mobilizing funds required from KMC to see the Meat waste management in full-fledged operation. - Agency should collect meat waste from every meat shop.
- Agency should take prior approval of disposal point.
- Agency should duly follow the pollution norms and hygiene.
- Irrespective of waste collected agency has to pay amount to KMC as per agreement conditions.
- The Agency should produce timely reports of quantity disposed on the performance every month or week as required by the concern.
- Salaries & operational expenses shall be provided by the agency.
- Agency should take prior Approval from the Pollution Control Board and dispose of as per the APPCB norms.
- KMC shall not responsible for any deviation in following pollution norms
- KMC shall not be responsible for any legal issues.
- The Agency shall not discontinue work during agreement period. Action will be initiated in case the agency discontinues the work during agreement period as per established procedure
